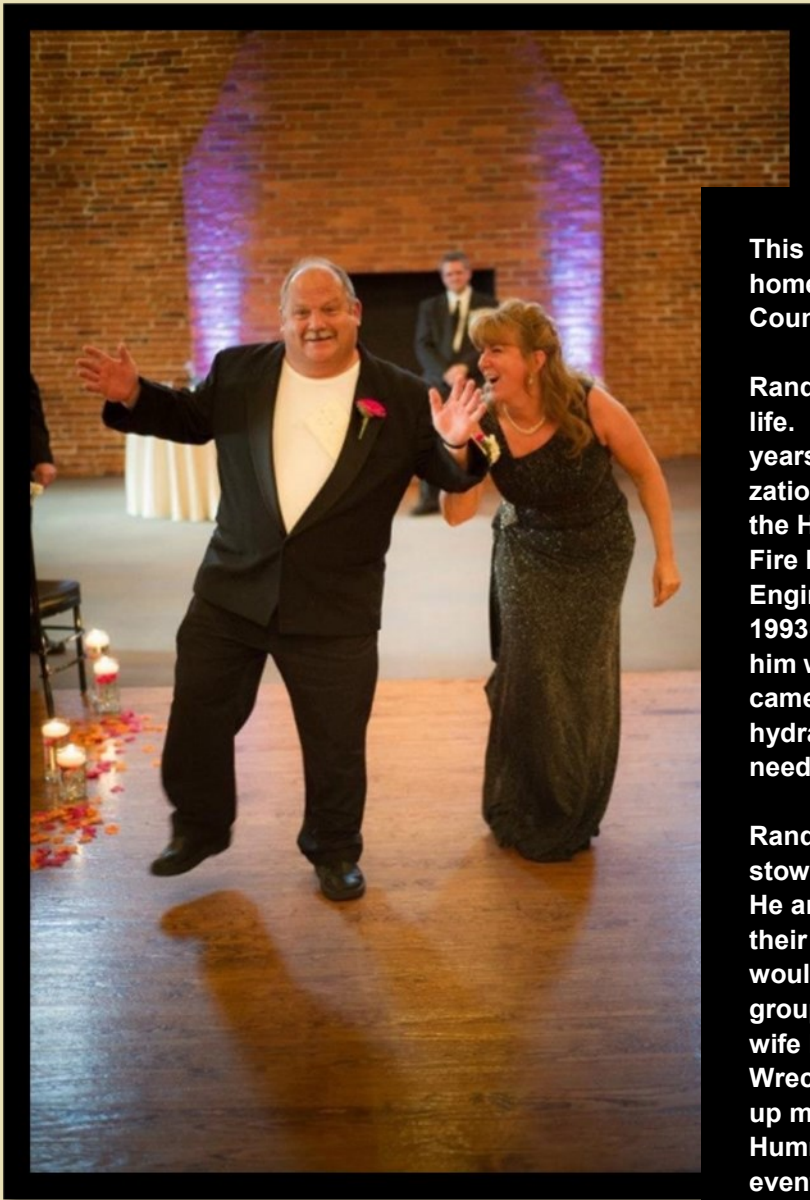


HUMMELSTOWN

Randy Lutz was a man who wore many hats during his life. He was a member of Borough Council for the last 17 years and was involved in numerous community organizations over the years including more than 30 years with the Hummelstown Fire Department. Randy joined the Fire Department in 1970 and held the position of Chief Engineer, then Assistant Chief and then Fire Chief from 1993-2002. His involvement in the fire company provided him with the expertise Borough Council needed when it came to "supporting the purchase of" fire trucks and fire hydrants with all their many types of connectors and the needed water flow to supply them.

Randy was a Republican Committee Person for Hummelstown and a member of Trinity United Methodist church. He and our late Mayor, Bradley Miller, were famous for their pots of chicken soup. On many occasions they would make soup and donate to Hummelstown non-profit groups. Randy enjoyed cooking so much, he and his wife Kerrin bought and operated a food truck (RK Food Wrecker). You may have seen his smiling face cooking up meats and soups at the Halloween Parade, Taste of Hummelstown, and as a regular at Cassel Vineyard's events.

Randy's participation on Council and in and around our community will be sorely missed. Our thoughts are with his family as they deal with this tremendous loss. We know he was proud of all his children and their families and had a twinkle in his eye whenever he would talk about his grandchildren.

Randy was truly a town father -- always looking out for what he thought was best for his hometown.

Autumn brings brilliant colors to the Borough's trees but fallen leaves can cause challenges for our sewers and streams.

Leaves left on the ground can block and clog storm drains, contributing to street flooding when it rains. Excess leaves can also cause nutrient pollution and oxygen depletion in our streams and rivers when carried there through storm drains and sewer pipes, which harms fish and other wildlife.

Do your part to help protect storm drains and streams:

- Do rake or blow your leaves onto the curbside. The Borough offers the service of collecting leaves at curbside. Please be mindful of your collection day service. Leaves out too early may end up in the storm drain or someone else's property.
- Do not pile leaves or other yard waste near storm drains.
- If you have a mulching lawnmower, use it to recycle leaves and their nutrients into your lawn.
- If you see leaves or other debris on top of a storm drain, carefully remove them and dispose of them properly, if safe to do so. However, never attempt to reach inside a storm drain or lift the grate.

If you see a clogged or broken storm drain, please call our Borough Office at 717-566-2555.

As Fall & Winter approach the Fire Department would like to remind residents of the following:

- Check your heating system.
- Clean your chimney if you burn wood to help prevent carbon monoxide incidents.
- Change batteries in smoke & carbon monoxide detectors.
- Have an emergency exit plan for your home.

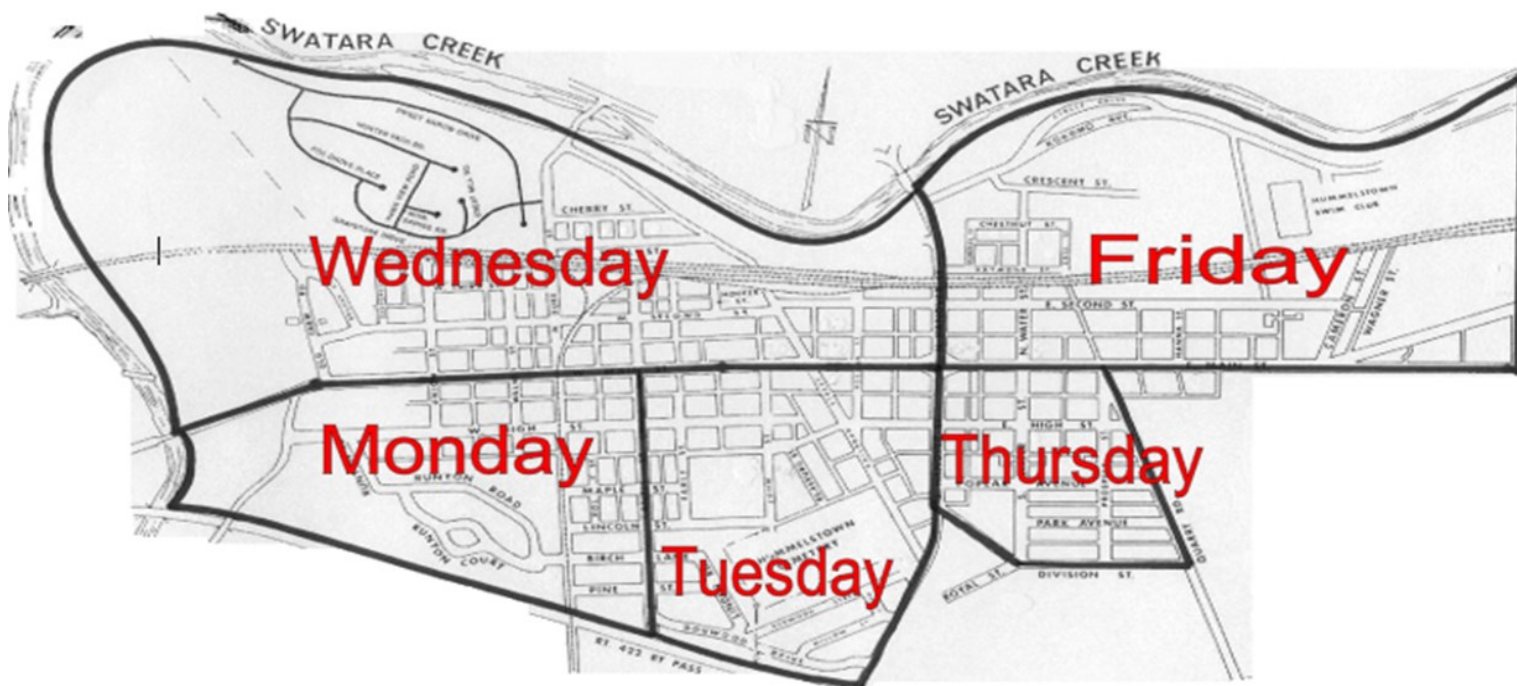
